












12. Document V immediately after unfolding (facing side). It was folded into four vertically.




13. Document V immediately after unfolding (rear side).










17. Document VI immediately after unfolding (facing side). There were some tears/slits.




18. Document VI, facing side. The tears were mended by pasting with Japanese paper.





20. Document VIII immediately after unfolding (facing side). It was folded into two vertically.




21. *Fāsī* numerals in the inventory on the margin of Document VIII.


