Bibliographical Notes

- I. This is a catalogue of Morrison Library's rare books including manuscripts (57), precious books (29), and old books (1,029); 1,115 books in total out of Morrison's entire collection.
- II. Descriptions of this catalogue are generally based on the Library of Congress "Bibliographic description of rare books", translated by Yoshitomi Okazaki in 1986.
 Exceptions:
 - a. Titles which in this catalogue do not use punctuations, abbreviations and ligatures, are minutely copied from information sources.
 - b. Duty positions and other licenses added to titles are copied without omission.
- III. Toyo Bunko uses its original classification system (classification into region and subject) for Western books which was created when Toyo Bunko was established, and this catalogue follows this system. Under each classification heading, name of books are listed in order of call numbers.
- IV. Descriptions of this catalogue are written in the following order: call number, author, title, edition, volume, publication, physical description, language, series, content, notes.

V. Index

- a. Author lists up to 2 people.
- b. For the books without author's name, the title of the book is used instead. The book of such titles appears next to the author's index.
